SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

- The Southsea Motor Club Ltd will organise a Clubmans Historic Sporting Trial at Bordean Lane, Froxfield Green, Nr Petersfield, Hants, GU32 1DJ (map reference 197/SU704249) on Saturday 21 March 2020.
- The meeting will be governed by the General Regulation of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these SRs and any written instructions the organising club may issue for this event.
- 3 Motorsport UK permit number:- 115943
- The event is open to all fully elected members of the organising club and members of one of the following invited clubs:-

BTRDA, 750 Motor Club, MCC, VSCC, HSCC, Stroud and District Motor Club, NPTCC, Midland Automobile Club, Woolbridge MC, Kentish Border CC, Falcon MC, Golden Valley HLCC and Midlands Trials Car Club.

When signing on all drivers <u>and passengers</u> must produce a Membership Card from the organising club or one of the invited clubs and a valid Competition Licence as per Blue Book Section T, page 349, para 3.1.5. and foreign drivers and passengers with an appropriate valid licence. Each competing car may have a maximum of 2 drivers.

Public roads will not be used to link the sections. There will be at least 3 rounds of at least 6 sections on private land. The entry will be split into groups, starting at different hills to enable the programme to be completed.

SCRUTINEERING STARTS AT 8.30 AM. COMPETITORS' BRIEFING 9.45.00 AM. FIRST TEST STARTS AT 10.15 AM.

ANY COMPETITOR NOT SIGNED ON BY 9.45 AM MAY BE EXCLUDED.

All cars will comply with the Motorsport UK technical regulations and with the Historic and Post Historic Sporting Trials Car Formula (Motorsport UK Yearbook Section T). Historic cars must be fitted with Blockley 4.50/5.00 x 18 tyres to the driven wheels.

HISTORIC as defined by HSTA.

POST HISTORIC as defined by HSTA.

8 Awards will be presented as follows:-

Best performance of the day: Ron Faulkner Trophy & Replica (Historic vehicles only)

First in each class: an award, subject to a minimum of 3 entries per class.

Trophies to be returned to Southsea Motor Club by end of February 2021.

- 10 Entry fees will be refunded if the Entries Secretary is notified of a competitor's cancellation by 12 noon on Friday 20 March 2020.

- 15 Competitors will be identified by numbers provided by the organisers.
- All other GRs of the Motorsport UK apply as written except 5.3.4: the running order will not be reversed during the event.
- 17 Starting numbers will be allocated by ballot.

- All competing cars <u>must</u> be fitted with an effective silencer, fire extinguisher and emergency whistle.
- 19 Please take advantage of the excellent catering facilities. We have Sam's catering again this year.
- No person may drive a competing car on the site except the authorised competitor.
- 21 All dogs must be on leads, this is a shooting estate.
- Double drives and shared drives are permitted. Please fill in two entry forms. "Shared drives" is a new concept and is different from a double drive. With a shared drive one competition number is issued and the competitors decided between themselves who drives on each hill. The score will be recorded against the car number. Shared drives are not eligible for awards. The entry fee of £60 covers one normal entry plus the permit fee for the extra driver.
