SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. The Southsea Motor Club Ltd will organise a Clubmans permit Historic Sporting Trial at Bordean Lane, Froxfield Green, Nr Petersfield, Hants, GU32 1DJ (map reference 197/SU704249) on Saturday 24th April 2021.
2. This meeting will be governed by the General Regulation of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these SRs and any written instructions the organising club may issue for this event.
3. Motorsport UK permit number:- 120804
4. The event is open to all fully elected members of the organising club and members of the following invited clubs:- BTRDA, 750 Motor Club, MCC, VSCC, HSCC, Stroud and District Motor Club, NPTCC, Midland Automobile Club, Woolbridge MC, Kentish Border CC, Falcon MC, Golden Valley HLCC and Midlands Trials Car Club.
5. Public roads will not be used to link the sections. There will be at least 3 rounds of at least 6 sections on private land. The entry will be split into groups, starting at different hills to enable the programme to be completed.
6. Scrutineering starts at 8.30am. First test starts at 10.30am.
7. Scrutineering will be a visual inspection conforming with Covid-19 restrictions. Competitors are expected to demonstrate that brakes and ignition cut-off switch function satisfactorily.
8. All cars will comply with the Motorsport UK technical regulations and with the Historic and Post Historic Sporting Trials Car Formula (Motorsport UK Yearbook Section T). Historic cars must be fitted with Blockley 4.50/5.00 x 18 tyres to the driven wheels.
9. Classes: HISTORIC and POST HISTORIC as defined by HSTA.
10. Awards for Driver and Passenger will be presented as follows:- Best performance of the day: Ron Faulkner Trophy & Replica (Historic vehicles only). First in each class: An award (subject to a minimum of 3 entries per class). Trophies to be returned to Southsea Motor Club by end of February 2022.
11. The entry list opens on publication of these ASRs and closes on Monday 19th April 2021. The entry fee is £55.00. All entries must be completed online using the official Purple Lap System. Payments should be by bank transfer to:

12. **Once you have entered by Purple Lap, some days before the event the system will email you and your passenger with the Motorsport UK Signing-On Declaration. You and your passenger will have to acknowledge receipt by email and this will replace the manual signing-on we previously undertook before the start of a trial.**
13. Entry fees will be refunded if the Entries Secretary is notified by telephone or email of a competitor's cancellation by 12 noon on Friday 23rd April 2021

19. All other GRs of the Motorsport UK apply as written. The running order will not be reversed during the event. All Competitors must comply with the appropriate Motorsport UK Covid-19 Guidance. *For safety reasons ALL competitors, irrespective of whether they are in the same household or bubble, must wear face masks when competing.*

20. Starting numbers will be allocated by ballot.

21. All competing cars must be fitted with an effective silencer, fire extinguisher and emergency whistle.

22. A first aider will be attendance.

23. Toilet facilities will be available.

25. No person may drive a competing car on the site except the authorised competitor.
