

## Midlands Trials Car Club Inaugural Heritage Sporting Trial 2021

## **Supplementary Regulations**

- Midlands Trials Car Club will organise a Clubman's Heritage Sporting Trial at Blackmoor Farm, Woolminstone, Crewkerne, Somerset, TA18 8QP on Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> July 2021
- 2. This meeting will be held under the General Regulations of the Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), and these Supplementary Regulations.
- 3. Motorsports UK Permit No. 121393
- The event is open to all fully elected members of the organising club and BTRDA, NPTCC, 750 Motor Club, MCC, HSCC, VSCC, MAC, Stroud and District MC, KBCC, Southsea Motor Club Ltd, Woolbridge MC, Falcon Motor Club, Dellow Register and Golden Valley HLCC
- 5. All drivers and passengers must produce a valid competition licence (minimum RS Clubmans) and be a member of a registered motor club.
- 6. Scrutineering starts at 9.30am, this will be a visual check in line with Covid restrictions, its location will be defined in the final instructions.
- 7. First hill at 10.30am. Any competitor who has not collected their onsite number and scorecard pack by 10.15am may be excluded.
- 8. The trial will consist of at least two rounds of at least six hills. The entry will be split into groups starting on different hills. Start hills will be determined by ballot. No practicing on the sections will be allowed. Competition numbers will be issued by the organisers as part of the onsite pack. Double drives are permitted provided they remain the same crew and meets Motorsport UK requirements each driver must submit an entry form.
- 9. Provisional classes: -
  - HERITAGE Class: Trials cars made before 1956 conforming to the 1953 RAC Trials Formula but NOT fitted with independent rear wheel braking (fiddle brakes) e.g., Dellow. These vehicles must be largely in original period specification e.g. still have an 1172 engine/gearbox/rear axle. Period modifications such as different head, additional carburettor, supercharger, or hydraulic brakes are considered acceptable as would later non-performance enhancing electrical modifications such as an alternator, electronic ignition or an electric water pump.
  - MODIFIED HERITAGE class: Trials cars made up to 1956 conforming to the 1953 RAC Trials Formula
    but NOT fitted with independent rear wheel braking (fiddle brakes) e.g Dellow. These vehicles may
    have sympathetic period modifications e.g. engine/gearbox/rear axle replaced with items first
    manufactured before 1970. An alternator, electric water pump, and electronic ignition is acceptable.
    Modifications such as non-period suspension, dampers, disk brakes, fuel injection, engine
    management and novel engine, gearbox and axle combinations will move the car to the Invitation
    class.

- Early Post War Trials Specials (Pre 1953 RAC Trials Formula) class: Purpose built largely original open trials cars constructed before 1953 and NOT conforming to the 1953 RAC Trials Formula e.g. Onslow Bartlett Specials, WHW Dellow, V8 Mercury, etc and not fitted with independent rear wheel braking (fiddle brakes).
- **Invitation class:** Open period trials cars that do not conform to the other classes but may be considered by the organisers as acceptable within the spirit of the meeting.
- 10. Awards: Awards will be presented to the drivers who finish 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> in each class subject to a minimum of four starters in each class. Organisers reserve the right to reallocate awards.
  - 11. The maximum entry for the meeting is 65; if entries exceed this number, entries will be accepted on a 'first come, first served' basis. The minimum is 20, should the minimum number not be reached the organisers reserve the right to cancel the event.
  - 12. Entries opens on the publication of the S.Rs and closes at 23.59pm on Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> June. Entries must be made on the official entry form and the entry fee must be paid <u>at least</u> 24 hours in advance of the event, payment will not be accepted on the day. Entries will be refunded in full with 24 hours' notice or cancellation of the event.

Entries must be on the Official Motorsport UK Entry form, as this covers your signing on as this will not be available onsite due to Covid restrictions.
