### **Paddock**

## Zandvoort Update #2 30th May 2023

Dear ZHGP Entrant

### Safety requirements for cars and drivers

A number of our UK based entrants have sought advise on the standard required for competing in the ZHGP for our race overalls etc

This morning I received the attached safety requirements that will operate at the ZHGP, and many of you will be relieved to see that it mirrors by and large, the Motorsport UK regulations with the exception of fireproof underwear, that is mandatory.

The FIA and SNELL codes are there to allow you to check it against your own equipment.

In my case, I am using a ten year old race suite, underwear, gloves and shoes to FIA Standard 8856.2000 that conforms, and a helmet, also ten years old, to Snell SA2010 that also conforms, although this is it's last year of conformity

## **KNAF minimum Safety requirements (Clubsport)**

(see also KNAF Reglementen Boek 2023, Algemeen Autorensport Reglement, Reglement: Clubsport, Articles 12 & 13)

### **Safety requirements drivers equipment (Art 13):**

- Clothing according to CSI appendix L with FIA norm 8856-2000 (or higher 8856-2018)
  - o Overall FIA norm 8856-2000
  - o Balaclava FIA norm 8856-2000
  - o Underwear FIA norm 8856-2000
  - o Shoes FIA norm 8856-2000
  - o Gloves FIA norm 8856-2000
  - o Socks FIA norm 8856-2000
- Helmets (crash helmets) according to CSI appendix L with norm (see TL 25);
  - o Snell SA2010, Snell SAH2010, Snell SA2015, (not valid after 31-12-2023)
  - o , FIA 8859-2015, , FIA 8860-2010 and FIA 8860-2018, preferable (but not obligatory) a FHR system.

- **Fire extinguisher:** CSI appendix J article 253.7.2 and 7.3.
- **Safety cage (ROPS):**
  - Touringcars & GT's: CSI appendix J article 253.8
  - Formula cars & Sportscars: CSI appendix J (2013), article 277, article 253.8 and 259.16.4.
  - Protective padding FIA 8807-2001 type A (List 23) according to App J 253.8.3 and drawing 253-68.
  - Rollbars with so-called S-shape / double bend in the front rollbar are no longer tolerated.
- **Windonet:** CSI appendix J article 253.11 or an arm restraint (conform SFI 14.2 or 3.3).
- **External circuit breaker:** CSI appendix J article 253.13
- **Fuel tanks & fillers:** CSI appendix J, article 253.14: Original tank or FT3 1999, FT3,5 or FT5 tank with FIA approval within date of validity.
- **Seat:** CSI appendix J article 253.16, FIA norm 8855-1999 with maximum age of 10 year or FIA 8862-2009 also maximum age of 10 year or 8855-2021.
- Seat mounting with minimum 4 fixation point, using bolts with minimum diameter of 8 mm, Quality 8.8 (ISO-norm) or higher and mounting plates of minimum 40 cm<sup>2</sup> at each fixation point (min. thickness for steel 3 mm, for aluminum 5 mm).

Paddock Area

Our original ZHGP entry estimate, as given by members earlier this year, was 19 and I upped that with the organisers to 22/23, but we are now at 26 entries, so room is going to be tight in our 30m x 10m marquee.

Please park only your race car and associated equipment in the covered area, with equipment to the rear of your car, and in this way I hope that we will all be able to squeeze in.

On current entry numbers, that means two rows of 13 cars with each one having a 2.3 m wide space by 5 m deep for the car and equipment.

Yes, I did ask the organisers for a larger marquee, but it was too late for them to respond, sorry!

On track access

In view of the difficulties in getting our cars moved around the paddock etc, the organiser have once again given us a special on track access direct from our paddock area through the North Gate into pit lane and then onto the track, thereby avoiding the necessity of going via an assembly area.
