

# Southsea Motor Club & 750 Motor Club Sporting Trials Centre present the

## **Historic Plum Pudding Sporting Trial**

Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> December 2024

### **Supplementary Regulations**

1. The Southsea Motor Club Ltd in conjunction with The 750 Motor Club Ltd will promote, with a Clubmen's Permit, a Historic Sporting Trial at Head Down, Buriton, near Petersfield, Hants, GU31 5SN on Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> December 2024.
2. The Meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of Motorsport UK (Incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting code of the FIA), these SR's and any written instructions the organising clubs may issue for the event.
3. Motorsport UK Permit Number: 200814
4. The event is open to all fully elected members of one of the organising clubs and members of the following invited clubs, BTRDA, NPTCC, MCC, HSCC, VSCC, MAC, Stroud and District MC, KBCC, Woolbridge MC, Falcon Motor Club, Dellow Register, Midlands Trials Car Club and Golden Valley HLCC..
5. The event will be at **Head Down, Buriton, near Petersfield, Hants GU31 5SN**. Public Roads will not be used to link sections. There will be 6 sections on private land to be attempted at least 3 times. The entry will be split into groups starting at different hills to enable the programme to be completed.
6. Scrutineering starts at 9.30am. First test: 10.30am
7. All cars will comply with the Motorsport UK technical regulations and with the Historic and Post Historic Sporting Trials Car Formula (Motorsport UK Yearbook Section T). Historic cars must be fitted with Blockley 4.50/5.00 x 18 tyres to the driven wheels. Permitted tyres for Post Historics as per 14.8.2 in Motorsport UK Yearbook.
8. Classes: HISTORIC and POST HISTORIC as defined by HSTA.
9. Awards to be presented as follows:-

Best Performance Historic Class	Driver and Passenger
2 <sup>nd</sup> in Historic Class	Driver and Passenger
Best Performance Post Historic Class	Driver and Passenger
