



# HSTA May 2 Day Trial 2026 on Saturday 16th & Sunday 17th May 2026 at Blackmoor Farm, Crewkerne

## Supplementary Regulations

1. The Midlands Trials car club will organise a 2 day Clubmans permit Sporting Trial on **Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> May and Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> May 2026** at Blackmore Farm, Woolminstone, Crewkerne, Somerset, TA18 8QP.
2. The meeting will be held under the National Competition Rules of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), by these Supplementary Regulations and by any other written instructions that the Organising Club may issue for this event.
3. Motorsport UK Clubman Permit Number is: 207295.
4. The event is open to all fully elected members of the organising club and BTRDA, NPTCC, 750 Motor Club, MCC, HSCC, VSCC, MAC, Stroud and District MC, KBCC, Southsea Motor Club Ltd, Woolbridge MC, Falcon Motor Club, Ilkley and District Motor Club, Isle of Wight Car and Dellow Register.
5. All drivers and passengers must produce a valid Club Membership Card at Signing-On, together with a minimum of an RS Clubman Competition Licence issued by Motorsport UK for 2026.
6. The event is not a Championship round.
7. Event Programme: Scrutineering and Signing On will start at **10:00am Saturday / 08.30am Sunday**  
Driver's Briefing will be at **11:15 Saturday and 09.30am Sunday**  
Any competitor not signed on by **11.15am / 9.30am Sunday may be excluded**  
The event will start at **11.30am Saturday / 09.45am Sunday**
8. There will be at least 6 sections on private land each day – details of the sections will be notified at Signing On/ Driver's Briefing. Public roads will not be used to link sections. The number of rounds will be determined by the weather and size of the entry.
9. The entry will be split into groups starting on different hill sections.
10. Practicing will not be permitted.
11. Competitors will be identified by a number card issued by the Organisers. These, along with Competitor's Score Cards, will be issued at Signing On. Start numbers will be allocated by ballot prior to the event.
12. The event will be divided into the following classes,  
Historic / Post Historic / Invitation
13. Double-drives and shared drives will be permitted.
14. Tyres - Rear -- Historic Class – Blockley 4.50/5.00x18  
- Post Historic Class – Any Tyres on List 3 (Tyres for Sporting Car Trials) in Motorsport Uk Year Books
15. A minimum tyre pressure will be applied on the day at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course. Checks may be carried out during the event to confirm compliance. A maximum of 12 penalty points can be applied for each breach of the rule.
16. Awards will be presented as follows

Best performance by an MTCC member



- 1<sup>st</sup> Best Overall Historic Class
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Historic
- 1<sup>st</sup> Best Overall Post Historic Class
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Post Historic
- Spirit of the Event

17. The maximum entry for the meeting is 65 and the minimum is 14. Should the minimum not be reached then the Organisers reserve the right to cancel the event or amalgamate classes. Entries will be selected on a 'first come, first served' basis.
18. The entry list opens on publication of these Regulations and closes finally at midnight on Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> May. All entries must be made via the official entry form on Purple Lap. Entries will not be accepted until receipt of the completed digital entry form that will be sent to invitees and payment of the entry fee.
